As a former consulting manager at IBM in the Nordic region specialised in radical changes in various businesses, Inger Sannes used this knowledge (ie being open, vulnerable, enduring failures, etc.) in her own journey to a professional sculptor

Her exploratory inner journey as well as the experience and ability to run large projects combined with her artistic expression has led to several major assignments and public works in Europe, Asia and the USA. Some examples are the FN monument in Strängnäs; Memorial to the victims of the plane crash in Umeå; the sculpture garden for children in Söderköping; "The healing Path", Frustuna Church and SAS Institute, Stora Frösunda, Solna in Sweden; The Oslo Innovation Award with a sculpture that she created every year for 8 years for the most innovative companies in Norway; "Sky Garden" a place for contemplation in Kowloon, Hong Kong; and the monumental marble sculpture ELEMENTS to Christopher Newport University in Virginia, USA

Inger Sannes has received the Art Prize from the City of Oslo and financial support from the Swedish Arts Council, the Swedish and Norwegian embassies in Rome and the Swedish Institute in Rome

Inger Sannes was born in Norway and shares her time between Sweden and Pietrasanta, Italy. She has been president of the Swedish Sculptors' Association and is also member of RBS (Royal Society of Sculptors, England) and the Norwegian Sculptors Society
